## For Older Learners:

A lot of important Bible accounts are often considered to be “kid’s stories” and Jonah is one of them. Now that you are older, it is important to begin looking more deeply into these accounts. This week’s activity will continue for the next two weeks, so here is what you need to do:

- Print out a copy of the book of Jonah (you can cut and paste the text from websites such as [biblegateway.com](http://biblegateway.com) into a Word doc)
- For this week, you will need three highlighters of different colors (or colored pencils if you prefer to underline)
  - o Go through the book and mark every time you find the word great, greatest, exceedingly
  - o With another color, mark each time the word hurled is used in chapter 1
  - o With the third color, mark every reference Jonah makes to be being in or under the water in chapter 2
